

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-114 ANNUAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN ADOPTION

WHEREAS, the 2019 Alabama Legislature has passed an Act 2019-002 that levies an additional excise tax on gasoline and diesel fuel, and

WHEREAS, the City of Gardendale to receive a portion of said tax beginning no later than January 2020, and

WHEREAS, the City of Gardendale shall expend funds as allowed in Act 2019-002 for the maintenance, improvement, replacement, and construction of roads and bridges maintained by a qualified county and municipality; As matching funds for federal road or bridge projects; for the payment of any debt associated with the road or bridge project; and/or for a joint road or bridge project with one or more adjoining counties and/or municipality pursuant to any agreement executed under the authority of state law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Gardendale, Alabama, while in a regular session on the 19th day of August 2019, at 7:00 p.m. sets forth the following annual transportation plan for expenditure of funds collected and distributed under said Act 2019-002:

SECTION 1. Estimated Annual Revenues to be receipted for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2020 is \$79,500.00.

SECTION 2. Projects mentioned in this annual transportation plan are based on the availability of funding and if listed project is not fully funded or completed any funds will be carried forward in a city depository account until such time the project is able to be completed and/or fully funded.

SECTION 3. The City hereby sets forth the following transportation plan:

Repave/Resurface Sharit Avenue


Repave/Resurface Mitzy Drive
